3-6 YEAR OLDS compete for MISS BABYBUD 2024 title.7-12 YEAR OLDS compete for MISS ROSEBUD 2024 title.13-18 YEAR OLDS compete for MISS BELLA ROSE 2024 title.

PLACINGS:

The remaining 20% of the monies raised will go towards the BEANSTALK Scholarship Program

3-6 YEAR OLD CATEGORIES: These are the categories judged at the pageant for the contestants 3-6 years of age.

- FORMAL: Contestants are to model their formal attire.
- <u>MOMMY/DADDY & ME</u>: Mommies or Daddies or Mom/Dad-like figures will match each the contestant in attire and model for the judges. Contestants are allowed to be as creative as they like in this category.
- <u>DANCE TALENT</u>: Contestants will be asked to perform a 30 sec routine to the song of their liking and choreography of their choice or comfort level. Songs as well as choreography must be language appropriate and family friendly. Original Choreography. They can have assistance from an older person in this section.

<u>SCHOLARSHIP MONIES RAISED WILL ACCOUNT FOR 40% OF THEIR SCORE</u>

7-12 YEAR OLD CATEGORIES: These are the categories judged at the pageant for the contestants ages 7-12 years old.

- <u>FORMAL</u>: Contestants are to model their formal attire.
- <u>PROFESSIONAL/INTERVIEW</u>: Contestants are to wear their best professional business attire look. In this category they will be asked a question based on current events (appropriate to their age) or questions about their aspirations and goals for their future.
- <u>DANCE TALENT</u>: Contestants will be asked to perform a 60-90 sec routine to the song of their liking and choreography of their choice or comfort level. Songs as well as choreography must be language appropriate and family friendly.

- <u>PROFESSIONAL/INTERVIEW</u>: Contestants are to wear their best professional business attire look. In this category they will be asked a question based on current events (appropriate to their age) or questions about their aspirations and goals for their future.
- <u>DANCE TALENT</u>: Contestants will be asked to perform a 60-90 sec routine to the song of their liking and choreography of their choice or comfort level. Songs as well as choreography must be language appropriate and family friendly.

FUNDRAISING

PEOPLE'S CHOICES AWARD

In this category, 1 photo (of your choice) of each contestant will be posted to THE CONCRETE ROSE DANCE ACADEMY Facebook page. The public will be able to vote for their favorite contestant by liking the picture. The contestant with the most likes will receive a \$25 gift card. This section is separate from the rest of the judged categories. A

different contestant can win this category from the person who wins overall. Each contestant will be given their own link to their picture so that parents/guardians can send family and friends straight to their picture to vote. Picture will be uploaded on JULY 12TH at 6pm.

THEME

"A NIGHT IN HOLLYWOOD" is the theme of this years pageant. For the opening act the contestants are required to wear their best Hollywood glam. Opening act attire should be something they can do minimal dance movements in.

CONDUCT

We expect all pageant participants and aides to conduct themselves in a manner consistent with good taste and decorum. Anyone who fails to act in an acceptable manner will be disqualified and asked to leave the premises of the pageant. This includes any participant whose aide is behaving in an unacceptable manner, regardless of the participant's own conduct.

DISQUALIFICATIONS

Any participant who is proven to have violated the rules of eligibility will be disqualified. Even after being crowned in any category, or as one of the runners-up, the title and all accompanying accoutrements will be retrieved. The next person in line will move up until we have an eligible winner and runners-up.
